REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible to vote in the 2021 elections, you must satisfy these three requirements.

- 1. Become a Lifetime Member no later than the calendar year prior to Election Day, or have paid Annual Membership dues no less than twice in the previous three calendar years and be a paid member at the time of the election.
- 2. Include your spouse's full name on the membership application to ensure eligibility to vote.
- 3. Present proper photo identification (e.g., driver's license).


OPTION 2
