Hepatitis C in Drug and Alcohol Settings

Join us for this free training to support your role in curing hepatitis C!

Online Training Session: Saturday 6 November 2021, 10:00am – 1:00pm (AEDT)

People who inject drugs represent approximately 90% of newly acquired hepatitis C (HCV) infections. This training aims to provide addiction physicians, general practitioners, nurse practitioners, and other clinicians working in Drug and Alcohol settings with the skills and knowledge to diagnose HCV, manage comorbidities and treat HCV.

This training will be delivered in three parts:

Part 1 – a 1.5-hour eLearning component to be completed before the online sessions

Part 2 – facilitated online Zoom session building on the eLearning content through interactive case study discussions facilitated in small groups

Part 3 – an HCV Capacity Strengthening Toolkit provided at the end of the training

Learning Outcomes:

- Describe risk factors for HCV, enabling discussions with clients around prevention and harm reduction
- Screen, order and interpret tests appropriately to diagnose chronic HCV infection
- Describe the recommended pre-treatment assessment, including liver disease staging
- Determine the appropriate antiviral therapy for treatment of HCV and explain treatment to patient
- Implement monitoring and post-treatment follow-up recommendations

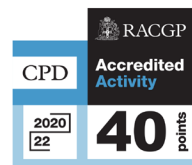
