Day 1 featured a hands-on Trauma Skills Lab hosted by GEMSA, where participants engaged in practical demonstrations of Direct/Video Laryngoscopy, EZ-IO, NIO, Chest Needle Decompression & Anatomy, Difficult Airway Simulation, and Bleeding Control & Wound Packing Simulation.

Day 2 brought together local subject matter experts who shared their knowledge on a variety of critical topics, including open fractures, blood management, engaging special needs communities, crush injuries, TXA for hemorrhage control, relevant case studies, and pre-hospital trauma.

This annual event was free for attendees and offered continuing education credits. It was a fantastic opportunity to advance trauma care skills and knowledge.
