

GEMA to Provide Infection Control Supplies to LTCF'S

Good afternoon Coalition Partners,

The Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency has purchased disinfectant supplies for long term care centers across Georgia. This includes skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities and personal care homes that are 25 beds or more. All centers will receive one (1) RidMold Air Armour fogger, four (4) cases of Air Armour disinfectant solution, two (2) Tyvek coveralls, and one spray bottle. Facilities will be contacted by their public health district to pick up their shipment. The provided supplies are the same as the Georgia National Guard used to disinfect centers. If a facility has any questions or concerns regarding the process, they can contact their local EMA to make a WebEOC request for the National Guard to provide in-person guidance. If a facility is going to request in-person training, they should do so as soon as possible to give the Guard the necessary time to schedule the trainings. The Guard will be able to complete the trainings through mid-July.
