COVID-19 and the Use of Thermal Detection Cameras in the Healthcare Environment

Please join us this **Friday, June 26, at 1 pm ET** for the 9th installment of the “**Securing the Health Sector**” webinar series, hosted jointly by InfraGard National Capital Region (InfraGardNCR), the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

With the ongoing pandemic, some of the most at-risk responders are those working in healthcare settings. Precautions must be taken for all patients entering a healthcare facility, whether or not their visit is for COVID-19 symptoms.

One way of safely screening patients is to check for fevers from a safe distance using thermal detection cameras. Our expert panelists will discuss implementing these devices and overcoming related challenges at Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Hospital and Northwell Health, including:

- What challenges is/was your organization facing?
- Why did you identify body temperature detection cameras as a solution?
- What criteria did you use to select a vendor?
- What results are you seeing?

- **Paul M Power, EMT-P, -** Assistant Vice President for the Workforce Safety Department at Northwell Health System, New York State's largest health care provider. With over 30 years of dedicated service to the emergency services and safety field, Paul has encountered some of the most dangerous and unsafe conditions one could imagine. Additionally, he has personally designed numerous safety devices that have saved countless healthcare professionals from serious injury.
- **Jonathan Westall, CHPA, CPP, PCI -** Vice President of Ancillary Services at MLK Jr. Community Hospital in South Los Angeles. He previously held multiple positions at Huntington Hospital in Pasadena including Manager of Security, Director of Security, and finally Director of Support Services. He is an IAHS volunteer leader, currently the International Board's VP/Secretary and previously the LA/OC Chapter Chair.
- **Mark Reed, CHPA -** Director of Support Services at MLK Jr. Community Hospital in Los Angeles, CA overseeing Security, Safety, Emergency Management, PBX, Parking, and numerous other programs. He previously was the Security Manager at Huntington Hospital in Pasadena. Mark is currently the Chair of the LA/OC

Chapter of IAHS, serves on the IAHS Foundation Board, IAHSF Research Committee, and is a member of the IAHS Guidelines Committee.
