

# Transition to Ending of National Guard Testing Assistance

The Georgia Army National Guard is continuing to support COVID-19 testing requests submitted via WEBEOC; however, this mission will begin wrapping up soon for the mobile testing teams (MTT). To facilitate the transition, the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) has been reviewing testing requests and helping determine if the testing needs can be fulfilled by DPH or a private vendor. If there is a need for the National Guard to support the facility through an MTT, this can be done until July 17. The National Guard will not accept WEBEOC requests after July 3 to ensure it can complete all requests by the July 17 deadline. Requests received after this date will be reassigned as appropriate.

Again - important dates to note:

3 July is the last day for WEB EOC requests for National Guard support. We will continue on with the current WebEOC

July 17th - Last day that National Guard will conduct MTT missions

We will continue with WebEOC assignments through the 17<sup>th</sup> of July. Also, as discussed with Ms. Dawona Hough, we have a work force cap assigned to the ongoing requests without any further bandwidth. Lastly, we are demobilizing over 1000 soldiers and airmen this week through a deliberate process which includes COVID19 testing, various out-processing tasks, quarantining/isolation, and taking accrued leave.
