UK Wide

Grants Online – UK wide funding database

<u>Gov.uk</u> – enter your postcode to find out if your local council has funding opportunities available.

<u>The Prince's Trust</u> don't currently offer funding for community projects but they do have a long list of other organisations across the UK that do.

<u>Co-operative Local Community Fund</u> - not for profit organisation and run a project that will benefit your local community. Open again in Spring 2021.

<u>Supermarkets</u> across the UK support communities through grants and other initiatives.

National Lottery Community Fund – Awards for All funding between £300-£10,000 for communities for both Covid responses/support and for business as usual activities available in each nation

Local School Nature Grant – up to £500. The Local School Nature Grants Programme is funding specifically for schools for outdoor resources, which can be chosen from a mix of over 100 different products.

Persimmon Community Champions – up to £1000 for community-based initiatives.

<u>Neighbourly.com: Covid-19 Community</u> - grants of up to £400, for existing members of Neighbourly in UK and Ireland whose work involves supporting members of the community suffering economically, socially or from ill health, as a result of the outbreak.



















England

Ford Small Grant – up to £200 for projects focusing on education, young people, SEND and environment.

<u>Local Connections Fund</u> – funding between £300-£2500 to enable local organisations to bring communities together.

<u>Near Neighbours</u> – currently offering grants to communities affected by the Covid pandemic up to £4000

Scotland

<u>Community Food Health</u> - A resource page of funding available predominately in Scotland

SCVO – Voluntary sector funding and advice

<u>Funding Scotland</u> – Sign up for free to find funding for your charity, community group or social enterprise using a free online search engine.

<u>Foundation Scotland</u> - diverse range of funding programmes for organisations working to benefit communities across Scotland.

Wales

<u>Funding Wales/Cyllido Cymru</u> - A one stop shop to search for funding opportunities of all sizes in Wales. They encourage people to get in touch with their local County Voluntary Council for support in developing their funding application.

Community Arts, Culture and Heritage Fund £2,000- £20,000

<u>Community Development and Health Network</u> - Funding from £2,5000 - £12,000 for interventions to support community health and wellbeing, opens Feb 21

<u>Community security funds</u> up to £150 e.g. to protect premises from community food banks to play equipment
